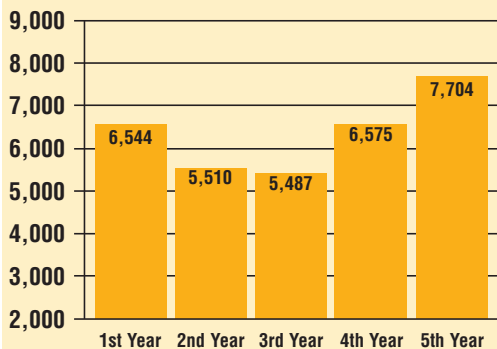


How Many Apprentices Do NECA-IBEW Local Programs Train?

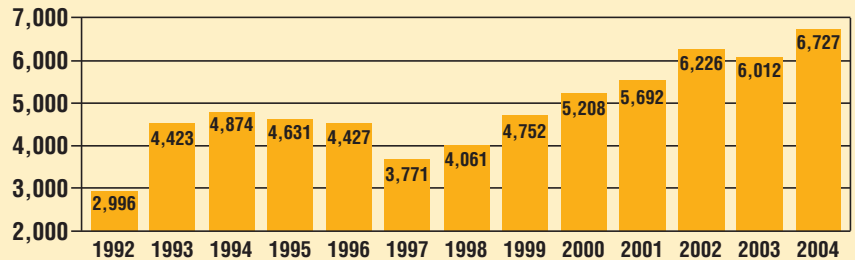
